PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Fees for the 20 week competition: \$270 (due by round 6)

- **Our Preferred method -Direct Deposit- BSB 062 347 A/C No 100 88 790.**
- Please use your Surname & MLC (Mon Ladies Comp) as a reference for payment.
- We also accept cash, credit card or cheques (payable to CHTA) in our pro-shop.

FORMAT/RULES:

- **20 weeks of play.**
- **Cost of Comp: \$270 per player.**
- **Format:** 3 Sets Doubles, Best of 8 games .Tie-breaker at 4 games all (First to 7 points).
- **DIVISION 2: Two full rounds (18 matches)/Semi Finals and Final. Prizes will be awarded for winners and runners-up.**
- **Toss/Changing ends:** Players toss before the **first set only**. Winner of the toss has the choice to either serve, receive or choice of end. The serve then alternates between teams and players for remainder of the match. Teams change ends after every 4 games. At 4-all teams change ends to commence the tie-break game. **(Please Note:** Team who serves first point in tie-break will serve second in the first game of the next set.)
- **TIMES: 9:15** - Players to warm up from 9:15. Match must start by 9:30.
- **POINTS** -1 point is awarded for each set won. A Bye match is counted as 3 points.
- **BYE** – not required to play but may be called as a reserve if available.
- **WET WEATHER**- All matches are assumed to be ON unless you receive message via sms. **Washed out matches will be played at the end of the round matches before the finals.**

Player's Code of Conduct:

CHTA aims to provide a positive sporting environment for all our players in our competitions.

We expect all players to respect the rights, dignity and worth of every player.

- Be fair, considerate and honest
- Display consistently high standards of positive behavior
- Do not use abusive language
- Consider the safety and well being of players at all times
- Promote fair play and not a "win at all costs" approach
- Follow the rules and etiquette of tennis

Ways to manage conflict:

- It is your obligation to call all balls on your side of the net.
- This call should be made honestly and fairly - but if in any doubt you must give the benefit of the doubt to your opponent and play the ball as **IN**.
- Any "out", "let" or "fault" call must be made immediately, loudly and clearly so the opponent can hear. If players disagree on a line call the call can be questioned but the final decision is with the player whose end the ball landed. In rare situations and if an agreement cannot be found the point should be replayed.
- Call the score out **after each point** loudly and clearly so all players can hear.
- If there is confusion or disagreement with the score and it cannot be agreed upon players need to calmly go back to the point in the game that both players agreed on the score. The rest of the game should then be replayed.
