DRAW INFORMATION

Order of Play:

1. Doubles
2. No 1 singles
3. No 2 singles
4. Doubles

Rules, Format & Scoring

- 4 sets (two sets of singles & two sets of doubles)
- Toss for choice of serve/end. This **choice** will then alternate between teams with each new set
- First to 6 games / 7-point tie-breaker played at 5 games all.
- Points - 1 point per set won and 2 bonus points for match winner ie: a maximum of 6 points per match.
- Match winner decided on sets first then games if score reaches two sets all.
- The 2 bonus points will be split in the case of a draw.
- If play is washed out the scheduled match will be played the following week.
- We reserve the right to make changes to the draw if required.
- **EACH PAIR PLAYS FOR THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF THE COMP (i.e. 16 weeks) INCLUDING SEMI-FINALS & FINALS.**

Player's Code of Conduct:

CHTA aims to provide a positive sporting environment for all our players in our competitions.

We expect all players to respect the rights, dignity and worth of every player.

- Be fair, considerate and honest
- Display consistently high standards of positive behavior
- Do not use abusive language
- Consider the safety and well-being of players at all times
- Promote fair play and not a "win at all costs" approach
- Follow the rules and etiquette of tennis

Ways to manage conflict:

- It is your obligation to call all balls on your side of the net.
- This call should be made honestly and fairly - but if in any doubt you must give the benefit of the doubt to your opponent and play the ball as **IN.**
- Any "out", "let" or "fault" call must be made immediately, loudly and clearly so the opponent can hear.
- If players disagree on a line call the call can be questioned but the final decision is with the player whose end the ball landed. In rare situations and if an agreement cannot be found the point should be replayed.
- Call the score out **after each point** loudly and clearly so all players can hear.
- If there is confusion or disagreement with the score and it cannot be agreed upon players need to calmly go back to the point in the game that both players agreed on the score. The rest of the game should then be replayed.
